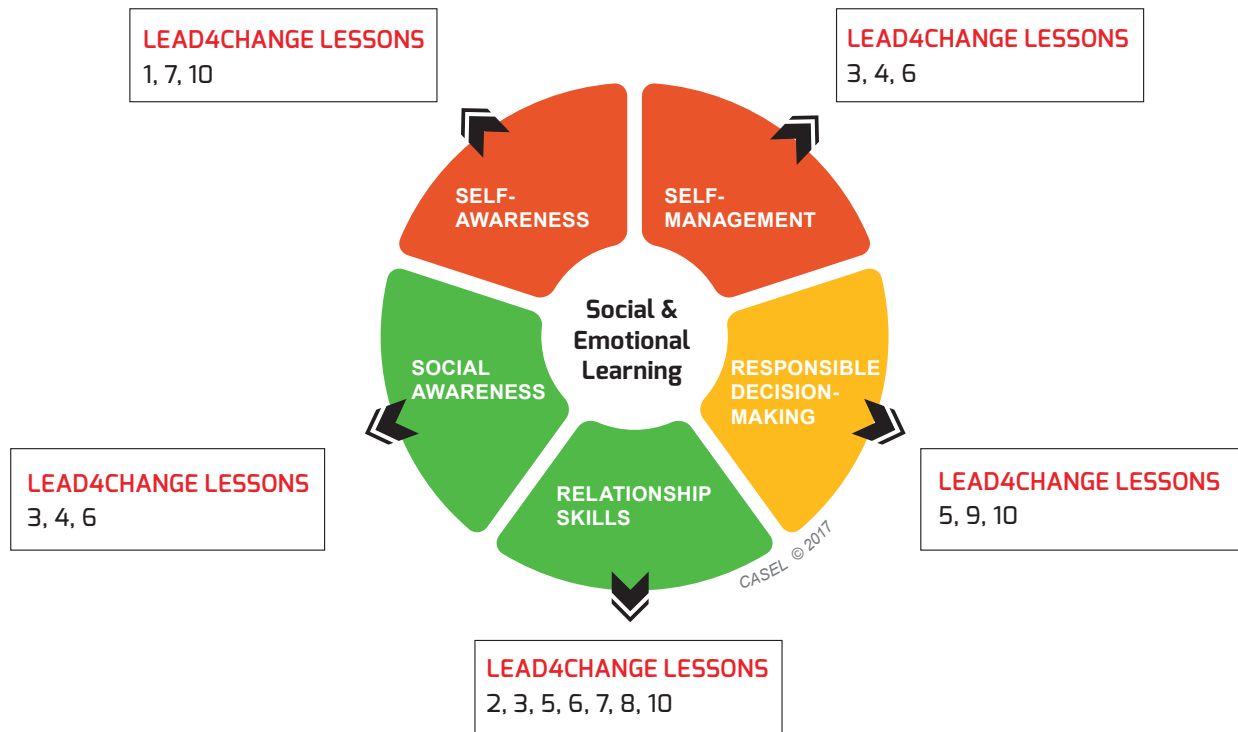


Lead4Change is a widely used and innovative student-led program that educates students about leadership and community service through classroom lessons. Leadership skills are developed as students practice by leading a project to benefit their school or community.

SELF-AWARENESS

Students assess their strengths and limitations by identifying and reflecting on events that have helped shape who they are.

- > Lifeline
- > 3 big questions
- > Self and team role reflection

SELF-MANAGEMENT

Students learn goal setting and organizational skills by developing and executing an action plan with their team that meets a school or community need.

- > Research
- > Action plan
- > Setting goals

RESPONSIBLE DECISION-MAKING

Students consider the well-being of others. Researching and analyzing school or community needs and working as a team to develop a solution requires problem solving and communication skills. Teams track their progress and adapt their actions to make necessary changes within their service project.

- > Tracking team progress

RELATIONSHIP SKILLS

Students work within a team framework to satisfy a school or community need. Students need to appreciate the strengths of others, communicate clearly, listen well, and cooperate in order for their team to be successful.

- > Developing a partnership with a non-profit

SOCIAL-AWARENESS

Students become socially aware and learn to empathize through research of a specific school or community need. Students recognize and appreciate the diversity of their school and local community.
